A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming territorial prison state
2 park and historical site; appropriating funds to complete
3 the plan for park development and operation; and providing
4 for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general
7 fund to the economic development and stabilization board
8 not to exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) to com-
9 plete planning for the development and operation of the
10 Wyoming territorial prison historic site and state park as

1 provided by W.S. 36-8-1001(d). In addition to other
2 requirements provided by statute, the plan shall include:

3 (a) Analysis of the park's soils, wildlife habitat,
4 floodplains, access and infrastructure;

5 (b) Evaluation of the feasibility and compatibility
6 of commercial, recreational and interpretive uses and
7 attractions;

8 (c) Identification of themes from Wyoming's territo-
9 rial history to guide decisions on appropriate uses and
10 attractions, architectural design of new structures, and
11 general compatibility of state park development with the
12 historic site;

13 (d) Formulation of a draft plan and up to four (4)
14 alternative development concepts;

15 (e) Public hearing on the draft plan; and

16 (f) Preparation of a final plan including the recom-
17 mended development concept, leasing and contract manage-
18 ment arrangements and an implementation process.

19 Section 2. The final plan shall be presented to the
20 legislature not later than January 1, 1988.

1 Section 3. This act is effective May 22, 1987.

5 prison buildings as state historical site.

6 (a) The state owned lands in Albany county described
7 as follows are declared to be a state park and historical
8 site:

9 (i) That portion of the West 1/2 of Section
10 32, Township 16 North, Range 73 West of the 6th P.M.,
11 Albany County, Wyoming, excluding that portion of the
12 operating right-of-way of the Union Pacific Railroad Com-
13 pany lying therein and excluding all lands called for AND
14 DESCRIBED in the following deeds AND DESCRIPTION:

15 (C) Quitclaim deed from the University
16 of Wyoming to the Wyoming highway commission dated Septem-
17 ber 23, 1974, recorded in Book 239, Pages 28 and 29, in

5 rial prison historic site and state park as provided by
6 W.S. 36-8-1001(d). The appropriation shall be obtained by
7 taking \$23,275 from the Chapter 67 Session laws of Wyoming
8 1982 Knight Hall heating, ventilating and planning project
9 and by taking \$1,725 from the Section 067, Chapter 61 Ses-
10 sion laws of Wyoming 1984, field house equipment project.
11 In addition to other requirements provided by statute, the
12 plan shall include:

13 (a) Analysis of the park's soils, wildlife habitat,
14 floodplains, access and infrastructure;

15 (b) Evaluation of the feasibility and compatibility
16 of commercial, recreational and interpretive uses and
17 attractions;

18 (c) Identification of themes from Wyoming's territo-
19 rial history to guide decisions on appropriate uses and
20 attractions, architectural design of new structures, and
21 general compatibility of state park development with the
22 historic site;

1 (d) Formulation of a draft plan and up to four (4)
2 alternative development concepts;

13 Section 5. This act is effective upon completion of
14 all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by
15 Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.


