7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 23.1-44(a) by creating a new para-
9 graph (xvi) and 23.1-79(e) and by creating a new subsec-
10 tion (f) are amended to read:

11 23.1-44. Miscellaneous fees.

12 (a) The following licenses and tags may be purchased
13 for the fee indicated subject to other requirements of
14 this act:

15 (xvi) PREDATOR CONTROL LICENSE.....100.00

1 23.1-79. Hunting from highway prohibited; entering
2 enclosed property without permission; hunting at night.

3 (e) No person shall hunt at night ~~upon--privately~~
4 ~~owned--or--leased--lands--except--with--written--permission--of~~
5 ~~the--landowner--or--lessee.~~ WITH THE AID OR USE OF ARTIFICIAL
6 LIGHT. THE POSSESSION OF FIREARMS BY A PERSON USING ARTI-
7 FICIAL LIGHTS WHILE HUNTING, locating or observing any
8 wildlife is prima facie evidence of a violation of this
9 subsection unless:

10 (i) THE PERSON HAS A PREDATOR CONTROL LICENSE
11 IF ON PUBLIC LANDS;

12 (ii) THE PERSON HAS WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE
13 LANDOWNER OR LESSEE OF PRIVATELY OWNED LANDS TO HUNT AT
14 NIGHT IF ON PRIVATE LANDS;

15 (iii) THE PERSON IS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
16 IN PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES; OR

17 (iv) THE PERSON IS AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMIS-
18 SION OR LAW TO ALLEVIATE WILDLIFE DEPREDAATION TO PRIVATE
19 PROPERTY.

20 (f) VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES A 7TH
21 DEGREE MISDEMEANOR.

1 Section 2. This act is effective ninety (90) days
2 after adjournment of the session of the legislature at
3 which it was enacted.
