(a) All cities and towns, owning their municipal water system or plant may enter into agreements with MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC customers whose lands lie outside the corporate limits, to supply water for the use, needs and requirements of such MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC customers. The water system may be extended and maintained beyond the corporate limits only when it is economically feasible in the opinion of the governing body. (ii) As to cities and towns which do not extend water service outside their corporate limits on the effective date of this enactment, the established rate shall be applied uniformly and shall not exceed two times the established rate within the corporate limits. -CHRISTENSEN
