 Section 1. W.S. 15.1-468(a) and (b) is amended to

- (a) All cities and towns, owning their municipal
 water system or plant may enter into agreements with

 the corporate limits, to supply water for the use, needs

- 1 and requirements of such MUNICIPAL AND DDMESTIC customers.
- 2 The water system may be extended and maintained beyond the

(ii) As to cities and towns which do not extend water service outside their corporate limits on the effective date of this enactment, the established rate shall be applied uniformly and shall not exceed two times the established rate within the corporate limits. -CHRISTENSEN
