12 Except as provided by this subsection, the lands within the boundaries of Fort Phil Kearney and Fetterman 13 Ridge state historic site, Independence Rock state historic 14 15 site and Hawk Springs state recreational area that are under 16 the control of the state shall not be leased, sold or 17 otherwise disposed of by any state agency without the 18 approval the legislature. The board land of 19 commissioners shall lease the lands specified in this 20 subsection at no cost to the division of state parks and for 21 cultural resources or its successor to be used 22 educational, historical, recreational and cultural purposes 23 by visitors to those sites.
