6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-1-110 and 36-8-601 by creating a
9 new subsection (c) is amended to read:

10

11 **36-1-110. Authority of director to effect and complete**
12 **exchanges.**

13

14 (a) The director is hereby authorized and empowered,
15 subject to the approval of the state board of land
16 commissioners, to effect and complete such exchange of
17 state-owned lands for federal-owned lands; and also to

1 effect and complete such exchange of state-owned lands for
2 privately owned lands; and to do any and all things
3 necessary or required to be done by the state of Wyoming in
4 order to enable said state to comply with the provisions of
5 said Taylor Grazing Act and other acts of congress
6 authorizing the exchange of federal-owned lands, and any
7 order, rule or regulation passed or promulgated in pursuance
8 thereof; and to do any and all things necessary to effect
9 and complete the exchange of state-owned lands for
10 privately-owned lands.

12 (b) Except as provided by this subsection, the lands
13 within the boundaries of Fort Phil Kearney and Fetterman
14 Ridge state historic site, Independence Rock state historic
15 site and Hawk Springs state recreational area that are under
16 the control of the state shall not be leased, sold or
17 otherwise disposed of by any state agency without the
18 approval of the legislature. The board of land
19 commissioners shall lease the lands specified in this
20 subsection at no cost to the division of state parks and
21 cultural resources or its successor to be used for
22 educational, historical, recreational and cultural purposes
23 by visitors to those sites.

5 legislature.
