6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-9-121(b) (intro) is amended to read:

10 **35-9-121. Local enforcement.**

12 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a)
13 of this section a local governmental entity is authorized to
14 assume joint plan review authority with the state fire
15 marshal, and that entity has sole construction inspection
16 authority on the approved plans, and sole authority for
17 periodic fire and life safety inspections on state owned or
18 leased buildings. If local code provisions conflict with

1 adopted state codes, the state code prevails. The
2 interpretation and application of fire, building and
3 electrical codes to state owned or leased buildings by local
4 governments under this subsection is subject to review by
5 the state fire marshal. The state fire marshal's decisions
6 regarding the application and interpretation of those codes
7 shall be final. The authority granted to local governmental
8 entities under this subsection is also subject to
9 certification of local inspectors as follows:

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 1999.
