DISTRIBUTION OF FOREST RESERVE FUNDS.

AN ACT amending and re-enacting Section 131 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1910, relating to the distributions of Forest Reserve Funds.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. That Section 131 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1910, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Section 131. Upon the receipt by the County Treasurer of the funds, as provided in Section 130, it shall be the duty of the County Commissioners of the County to direct said moneys to be credited to the general school fund and the road fund of their respective counties, apportioning said moneys between said two funds in amounts as they desire; provided, that five per cent (5%) of said moneys is the minimum amount that shall be credited to either one of said funds."

- Sec. 2. All acts or parts of acts in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
