AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section
4453, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920,
relating to shutting off Cross-cuts in
coal mines.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

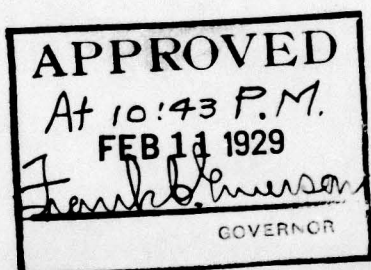
Section 1. That Section 4453, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, be
amended and re-enacted to read as follows:_____

Section 4453. It shall be the duty of every person, company or corpora-
tion, owning or operating coal mines, to shut off all unused cross-cuts between
main entries or cross entries and air courses, with a tightly built wall
or stopping of incombustible material and air tight construction; said wall
to be kept at all times in perfect condition and repair. Provided, that
panel slopes or panel entries shall not be driven more than 1000 feet be-
yond or in advance of incombustible stoppings._____

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after
June 1, 1929._____
