AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 4453, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, relating to shutting off Cross-cuts in coal mines.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 4453, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:_____

Section 4453. It shall be the duty of every person, company or corporation, owning or operating coal mines, to shut off all unused cross-cuts between main entries or cross entries and air courses, with a tightly built wall or stopping of incombustible material and air tight construction; said wall to be kept at all times in perfect condition and repair. Provided, that panel slopes or panel entries shall not be driven more than 1000 feet beyond or in advance of incombustible stoppings.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after June 1, 1929.
