1 AN ACT relating to state government programs; providing a
2 process to identify increases in the number of state
3 programs and to take action to avoid a net increase in the
4 number of state programs; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-1-117 is created to read:

10

11 **28-1-117. "No net new programs" process; definitions;**
12 **required reports.**

13

14 (a) As used in this section:

15

1 (i) "State program" means any program on the
2 state program list;

3

4 (ii) "State program list" means the list of
5 state programs created under subsection (b) of this section
6 and on file in the secretary of state's office.

7

8 (b) The secretary of state shall maintain a list of
9 state programs as provided in this subsection. The state
10 program list shall consist of:

11

12 (i) All programs listed in Appendix D of the
13 final report of the joint legislative-executive revenue and
14 expenditure study, dated September 30, 1999, on file in the
15 secretary of state's office; and

16

17 (ii) All additions to or deletions from the list
18 in paragraph (i) of this subsection under the procedures in
19 subsection (c) of this section.

20

21 (c) Within forty-five (45) days after the end of each
22 legislative session, the management council shall compile
23 and submit to the governor and secretary of state an
24 amendment to the state program list. This amendment shall

1 contain all new state programs created and all existing
2 state programs deleted by legislation enacted during that
3 legislative session. This amendment is subject to the
4 following process:

5

6 (i) If the governor does not object to that
7 amendment within thirty (30) days of receipt, the secretary
8 of state shall amend the state program list in accordance
9 with that amendment;

10

11 (ii) If the governor does object to the
12 amendment, the management council and the governor shall
13 have thirty (30) days from the date of the objection to
14 submit to the secretary of state an amendment approved by
15 both the governor and the management council. If an
16 amendment approved by both is submitted in a timely manner,
17 the secretary of state shall amend the state program list
18 in accordance with that amendment;

19

20 (iii) If no amendment approved by both the
21 governor and the management council is submitted within
22 that thirty (30) day period, no amendment shall be made to
23 the list under this subsection;

24

1 (iv) The governor's objection to an amendment
2 under paragraph (ii) of this subsection shall be submitted
3 to the management council by delivery to the legislative
4 service office.

5
6 (d) If an amendment under subsection (c) of this
7 section results in an increase in the total number of
8 programs on the state program list, the management council
9 shall submit, or cause to be submitted by another
10 legislative committee, a recommendation to the next
11 legislature to delete programs from the state program list
12 in the same number by which the amendment increased them.
13 The recommendation shall include legislation sponsored for
14 introduction by legislators or a legislative committee.

15

16 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-2-1013 by creating a new subsection
17 (e) is amended to read:

18

19 **9-2-1013. State budget; distribution of copies to**
20 **legislators; copies and reports of authorizations.**

21

22 (e) In addition to the items contained in subsection
23 (a) of this section, the governor shall identify any new
24 state programs created in his state budget recommendations.

1 To the extent that the governor identifies new state
2 programs, the state budget recommendations shall contain
3 recommendations to delete a like number of existing state
4 programs. For the purpose of this subsection, "existing
5 state programs" means any state program on the state
6 program list created under W.S. 28-1-117.

7

8 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2000.

9

FISCAL NOTE
