11	Section 1. W.S. 21-7-102(a)(ii) and (vi), 21-7-110(a)
12	and (b) and 21-7-111(b) are amended to read:

16	(a) As used in the article: <u>the following definitions</u>
17	shall-apply:

"Continuing Contract Teacher". (ii) means 1 а teacher who is not fulfilling a mandatory two (2) year 2 period of initial contract status pursuant to subparagraph 3 (a) (ii) (C) of this section and who has: 4 5 Any initial contract teacher who has 6 (A) Been employed by the same school district in the state of 7 Wyoming as an initial contact teacher for a period of three 8 9 (3) four (4) consecutive school years, and has had his contract renewed for a **fourth** fifth consecutive school year; 10 11 or 12 (B) A -teacher who has Achieved continuing 13 14 contract status in one (1) district, and who without lapse of time has taught two (2) three (3) consecutive school 15 years and has had his contract renewed for a third fourth 16 17 consecutive school year by the employing school district; 18 (C) A teacher, after achieving continuing 19 20 contract status pursuant to subparagraph (a)(ii)(A) or (B) of this section in any one (1) district for a period of five 21 (5) consecutive school years, shall be returned to initial 22 contract status for a period of two (2) consecutive school 23 24 years immediately following each five (5) year period and shall not be considered a continuing contract teacher for 25

1 the two (2) year period of initial contract status. The 2 teacher shall be returned to continuing contract status upon renewal of his contract for a third consecutive school year 3 following the two (2) consecutive school years of initial 4 5 contract status. 6 7 "Suspension"- means the removal of a teacher (vi) from the classroom during the school year, which is without 8 9 termination of salary pending a hearing under W.S. 21-7-110(c) through (g) and may be with termination of salary 10 after the hearing; 11 12 Suspension or dismissal of teachers; notice; 13 21-7-110. informal conference by superintendent; hearing; independent 14hearing officer; board review and decision; appeal. 15 16 The superintendent may temporarily suspend or 17 (a) dismiss any teacher and the board may suspend or dismiss any 18 teacher or terminate any continuing contract teacher for 19 incompetency, neglect of duty, immorality, insubordination, 20 unsatisfactory performance or any other good or just cause. 21 22 Suspension or dismissal proceedings shall be 23 (b) initiated by the superintendent or any member of the board 24 25 designated by the superintendent or designated by the board

pursuant to a majority vote of the board delivering to the 1 a written notice of suspension or dismissal, 2 teacher together with written reasons. After delivery of notice of 3 proposed suspension or dismissal, the superintendent may 4 schedule and conduct an informal conference with the teacher 5 6 concerning the reasons for suspension or dismissal. If after the informal conference, the superintendent determines that 7 suspension or dismissal is in the best interests of the 8 district, he may temporarily suspend or dismiss the teacher 9 with pay pending a final decision by the board following a 10 hearing in accordance with subsections (c) through (g) of this 11 section. If suspension or dismissal is continued by order of 12 13 the board pursuant to subsection (g) of this section, any 14 period of suspension or dismissal may be without pay. 15 16 21-7-111. Inapplicability of provisions. 17 18 (b) Nothing in this article including the duty to provide a reason for termination of an initial contract 19

20 teacher's employment, shall be interpreted as requiring any 21 hearing or as requiring any proof of cause <u>if prior to</u> 22 <u>termination of an initial contract teacher</u>. School 23 districts are not prohibited from providing may by policy or 24 contract, <u>provide</u> additional procedures or rights to initial 25 contract teachers.
