



A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public lands; providing for acceptance of
2 federal lands as specified; requiring a management plan as
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-10-110 is created to read:

8

9 **36-10-110. Acceptance of federal lands by the state;**
10 **vote required.**

11

12 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, prior
13 to the transfer of ownership of any federal land to the
14 state of Wyoming, the state land and farm loan office shall
15 prepare a land use management plan setting forth in detail
16 how the land will be used by the state if ownership is
17 transferred to the state. The plan shall be submitted to

1 the legislature prior to the transfer and shall be subject
2 to legislative approval. The management plan shall provide
3 for the optimum benefit and use of all the people of this
4 state of the lands in conformity with established concepts
5 of multiple use and sustained yield which will permit the
6 development of uses for agriculture, grazing, recreation,
7 minerals, timber and the development, production and
8 transmission of energy and other public utility services.
9 The plan shall permit the conservation and protection of
10 watersheds and wildlife habitat, and historic, scenic, fish
11 and wildlife, recreational and natural values. The plan
12 shall consider:

13

14 (i) Policy and program regarding disposal, lease
15 or exchange of any lands or resources acquired pursuant to
16 this act;

17

18 (ii) Policy and program regarding public access
19 to use of such lands;

20

21 (iii) Conservation of lands for wildlife habitat
22 or recreational purposes; and

23

1 (iv) Program regarding use or transfer of lands
2 to municipalities and other governmental entities for public
3 purposes.

4

5 (b) Any transfer of ownership of federal lands shall
6 not be effective until approved by the legislature. This
7 requirement shall not apply to any exchange of federal lands
8 for state lands.

9

10 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
11 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
12 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
13 Constitution.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-10-110 is created to read:

9

10 **36-10-110. Acceptance of federal lands by the state;**
11 **vote required.**

12

13 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, prior
14 to the transfer of ownership of any federal land including
15 any minerals to the state of Wyoming, the state land and
16 farm loan office shall prepare a land and minerals use
17 management plan setting forth in detail how the land and any

1 minerals will be used by the state if ownership is
2 transferred to the state. The plan shall be submitted to
3 the legislature prior to the transfer and shall be subject
4 to legislative approval. The management plan shall provide
5 for the optimum benefit and use of all the people of this
6 state of the lands including any minerals in conformity with
7 established concepts of multiple use and sustained yield
8 which will permit the development of uses for agriculture,
9 grazing, recreation, minerals, timber and the development,
10 production and transmission of energy and other public
11 utility services. The plan may permit the conservation and
12 protection of watersheds and wildlife habitat, and historic,
13 scenic, fish and wildlife, recreational and natural values,
14 and promote resource development and agricultural uses. The
15 plan shall consider:

16

17 (i) Policy and program regarding disposal, lease
18 or exchange of any lands or resources acquired pursuant to
19 this act;

20

21 (ii) Policy and program regarding public access
22 to use of such lands;

23

24 (iii) The potential financial impact to the state
25 and local communities;

1

2 (iv) Program regarding use or transfer of lands
3 to municipalities and other governmental entities for public
4 purposes; and

5

6 (v) Potential for resource development and
7 agricultural uses.

8

9 (b) Any transfer of ownership of federal lands
10 including any minerals shall not be effective until approved
11 by the legislature. This requirement shall not apply to any
12 exchange of federal lands and minerals for state lands and
13 minerals.

14

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 1997.
