
Resource Development Group Oil & Gas LLC (RDG Oil & Gas, LLC) is in the process of obtaining operatorship of the North Tisdale Lakota Unit from New Tech Oil Company (NTO).

RDG and NTO would like to maintain this Discharge Permit even though we do not currently, nor have we discharged produced Lakota water from some time. We anticipate a change of development plan for this field that will require more water for a water flood than is available from our Lakota production. Therefore, we do not anticipate produced water discharge but would like to keep the status of the Permit as Active.
