

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to create W.S. 9-145.1 relating to legislative
2 participation in composition of state boards and commis-
3 sions; and providing for an effective date.

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

5 Section 1. W.S. 9-145.1 is created to read:

6 9-145.1. Legislative representation on state boards
7 and commissions. All state boards and commissions estab-
8 lished by law in Wyoming shall include in their membership
9 a member of the senate, appointed by the president, and a
10 member of the house of representatives, appointed by the
11 speaker. The legislative members shall not be of the same
12 political party. They shall have the same powers and
13 duties as the existing board and commission membership.

1 Section 2. This act is effective May 28, 1976.
