FOR

AN ACT requiring school districts to submit to the State Board of Education the preliminary plans and specifications of school buildings or additions thereto to be constructed within the district and providing authority for the employment of a consulting architect.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. No school building or addition thereto shall be contracted for or constructed in any school district, until the preliminary plans and specifications shall be submitted to the State Board of Education for their examination and recommendations.

The State Board of Education may secure the services of a legally licensed Wyoming resident architect for professional and technical assistance in conducting their examination of the preliminary plans and specifications.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
