

A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to Article 3,
2 Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Wyoming to
3 limit the number of consecutive terms a senator or repre-
4 sentative can serve.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
6 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
7 separately, concurring therein:

8 Section 1. The following amendment to Article 3,
9 Section 2 of the Wyoming Constitution is proposed for sub-
10 mission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
11 next general election for approval or rejection, to become
12 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a

1 majority of the electors. The amendment is as follows:

2 Article 3, Section 2. Members' terms and qualifica-
3 tions. Senators shall be elected for the term of four (4)
4 years and representatives for the term of two (2) years.
5 NO PERSON IS ELIGIBLE FOR ELECTION TO THE SENATE FOR MORE
6 THAN THREE (3) CONSECUTIVE TERMS OR TO THE HOUSE OF REPRE-
7 SENTATIVES FOR MORE THAN SIX (6) CONSECUTIVE TERMS. The
8 senators elected at the first election shall be divided by
9 lot into two (2) classes as nearly equal as may be. The
10 seats of senators of the first class shall be vacated at
11 the expiration of the first two (2) years, and of the
12 second class at the expiration of four (4) years. No
13 person shall be a senator who has not attained the age of
14 twenty-five (25) years, or a representative who has not
15 attained the age of twenty-one (21) years, and who is not
16 a citizen of the United States and of this state and who
17 has not, for at least twelve (12) months next preceding
18 his election resided within the county or district in
19 which he was elected.

20 Section 2. The Secretary of State of Wyoming shall
21 endorse the following statement on the proposed amendment.

22 The adoption of this amendment will limit to three
23 (3) the number of consecutive terms for which a state

1 senator can be elected and to six (6) the number of con-
2 secutive terms for which a state representative can be
3 elected.
