## ASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 32-506, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, as amended by Chapter 201, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1955, relating to the assessment of property in the State of Wyoming; and providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

## Real Property To Be Listed Yearly—Exception—Real and Personal Property Assessed At Fair Value

Section 1. That Section 32-506, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, as amended by Chapter 201, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1955, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

32-506. All real property with the exception of Federal and State lands, and such other lands as may be designated by the Legislature is to be listed each year, and all taxable real and personal property is to be valued and assessed at a fair value in conformity with values and procedures prescribed by the State Board of Equalization in conformity with Section 32-711, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, and other applicable laws.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
