

H. B. No. 58 Introduced by: Sherard, Mitchell, Yoder, Kurtz

AN ACT relating to domestic corporations and corporations organized without any purpose of direct gain to its stockholders; to amend and re-enact Section 44-109, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 127, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1953, providing for directors, their number, election, qualifications and terms of office; to amend and re-enact Section 44-114, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, providing for the majority required for the election and transaction of business; to amend and re-enact Sections 44-132 and 44-134, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, providing for the procedure for amending the certificate of incorporation of such a corporation.
