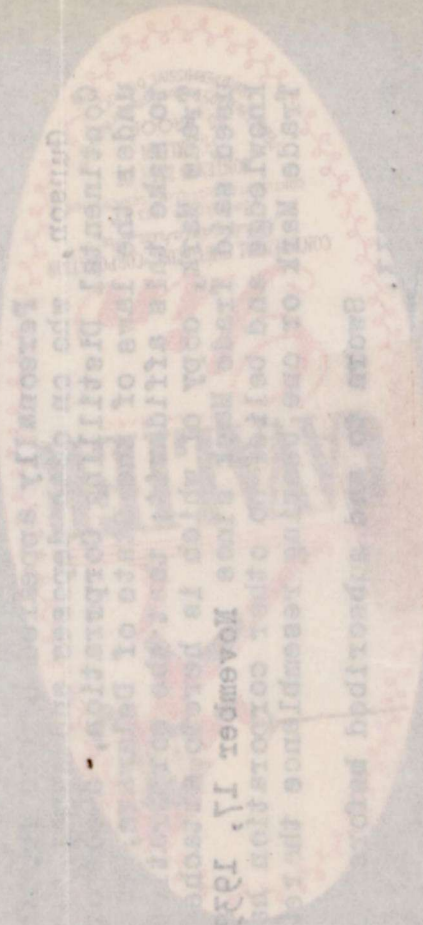

APPLICATION FOR PROTECTION OF TRADE MARK

To the Secretary of the State of Wyoming:

Be it known, That Continental Distilling Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware and having its principal place of business at Snyder and Swanson Streets, in the City of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, hereby makes application for filing in the office of Secretary of State of Wyoming, under the Common Law, and to be held as evidence of such rights as are recognized by the Common Law, and for the protection of Trade Marks as recognized by the statutes of said State of Wyoming - the Trade Mark, duplicate facsimiles of which are filed herewith and made part of this application.
