1 mission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the 2 next general election for approval or rejection, to become valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a 3 4 majority of the electors voting at the election: 5 ARTICLE 3, SECTION 25. VOTE REQUIRED TO PASS BILL. 6 Except as otherwise provided in this section, no bill 7 shall become a law except by a vote of a majority of all the members elected to each house, nor unless on its final 8 9 passage the vote taken by ayes and noes, and the names of those voting be entered on the journal. In cases where 10 11 members of a house have been excused from voting on a bill due to a conflict of interest, and have not voted on that 12 bill, then and only then, the number of such members 13 14 declaring a conflict and excused from voting on that bill shall be subtracted from the total number of members 15 elected to that house in computing the majority necessary 16 to pass that bill. 17

Section 2. The following statement shall be endorsed on the foregoing proposed amendment by the Secretary of State of Wyoming:

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1	The adoption of this amendment will provide that mem-
2	bers of a house excused from voting, and not voting, on a
3	bill due to a conflict of interest will not be counted in
4	determining the number of votes necessary for passage of
5	that bill from that house.
