

8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
9 separately, concurring therein:

10 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
11 Constitution, Article 3, Section 25 is proposed for sub-

1 mission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
2 next general election for approval or rejection, to become
3 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a
4 majority of the electors voting at the election:

5 ARTICLE 3, SECTION 25. VOTE REQUIRED TO PASS BILL.
6 Except as otherwise provided in this section, no bill
7 shall become a law except by a vote of a majority of all
8 the members elected to each house, nor unless on its final
9 passage the vote taken by ayes and noes, and the names of
10 those voting be entered on the journal. In cases where
11 members of a house have been excused from voting on a bill
12 due to a conflict of interest, and have not voted on that
13 bill, then and only then, the number of such members
14 declaring a conflict and excused from voting on that bill
15 shall be subtracted from the total number of members
16 elected to that house in computing the majority necessary
17 to pass that bill.

18 Section 2. The following statement shall be endorsed
19 on the foregoing proposed amendment by the Secretary of
20 State of Wyoming:

1 The adoption of this amendment will provide that mem-
2 bers of a house excused from voting, and not voting, on a
3 bill due to a conflict of interest will not be counted in
4 determining the number of votes necessary for passage of
5 that bill from that house.
