4 Article 5, Section 17. Salaries of judges of supreme 5 and district courts. The judges of the supreme and dis-6 trict courts shall receive such compensation for their 7 services as may be prescribed by law, which compensation 8 shall not be increased or diminished during the term for 9 which a judge shall-have-been IS elected,-and-the-salary 10 of-a-judge-of-the-supreme-or-district-court--shall--be--as 11 may-be-prescribed-by-law, OR APPOINTED EXCEPT AS HEREAFTER provided. 7-hewever7-that-when IF any legislative increase 12 13 or decrease in the salary of the justices or judges of 14 such EITHER THE SUPREME OR DISTRICT courts whose respec-15 tive terms of office do not expire at the same time, has 16 heretofore-or-shall-hereafter-become BECOMES effective as 17 to any member of such EITHER court, it shall-be IS effec-18 tive from such THAT date as to each--ef--the ALL members 19 thereof OF BOTH COURTS.
