10 Section 1. The following amendment to Article 5,
 11 Section 17 of the Wyoming Constitution is proposed for

2 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a
3 majority of the electors. The amendment is as follows:

4 Article 5, Section 17. Salaries of judges of supreme
5 and district courts. The judges of the supreme and dis-
6 trict courts shall receive such compensation for their
7 services as may be prescribed by law, which compensation
8 shall not be increased or diminished during the term for
9 which a judge shall-have-been IS elected, ~~and the salary~~
10 ~~of a judge of the supreme or district court shall be as~~
11 ~~may be prescribed by law,~~ OR APPOINTED EXCEPT AS HEREAFTER
12 provided, ~~however, that when~~ IF any legislative increase
13 or decrease in the salary of the justices or judges of
14 such EITHER THE SUPREME OR DISTRICT courts whose respec-
15 tive terms of office do not expire at the same time, has
16 ~~heretofore or shall hereafter become~~ BECOMES effective as
17 to any member of such EITHER court, it shall-be IS effec-
18 tive from such THAT date as to each--of--the ALL members
19 thereof OF BOTH COURTS.

1 Section 2. The Secretary of State of Wyoming shall
2 endorse the following statement and the proposed amend-
3 ment:

4 The adoption of this amendment will permit an
5 increase or decrease in judicial salaries to become effec-
6 tive for all judges of the supreme and district courts
7 whenever it becomes effective as to any judge of the
8 supreme or district courts.
