A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to create sections 27-264.1 and 27-264.2 of the  
2 statutes relating to the use of polygraph or other  
3 lie-detecting devices; prohibiting examination by such  
4 devices as a condition of employment; and providing pen-  
5 alties.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

7 Section 1. Sections 27-264.1 and 27-264.2 of the  
8 statutes are created to read:

9 27-264.1. Lie detector tests. No person either  
10 personally or through an agent or representative may  
11 request or suggest to a person in his employ or to a  
12 person who has an application for employment pending  
13 before him or require as a condition of employment that  
14 the employee or applicant submit to an examination in  
15 which a polygraph or other lie-detecting device is used.

16 27-264.2. Same; penalty for violation. A person who  
17 violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
