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

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 21.1-228 by creating a new subsection
2 (m) and 21.1-232 by creating a new subsection (f) and
3 amending and renumbering existing subsection (f) as (h);
4 defining career education; providing for funds under the
5 foundation program for the development and maintenance of
6 career education; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 21.1-228 by creating a new subsection
9 tion (m) and 21.1-232 by creating a new subsection (f) and
10 amending and renumbering existing (f) as (h) are amended
11 to read:

12 21.1-228. Definitions. For the purpose of this
13 article:

14 (m) "CAREER EDUCATION" MEANS A SYSTEMATIC, COMPRE-
15 HENSIVE AND CONTINUAL TEACHING PROCESS FROM KINDERGARTEN
16 THROUGH THE TWELFTH GRADE DESIGNED TO TEACH STUDENTS THE

1 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN ACADEMIC COURSES OF INSTRUCTION AND
2 THEIR APPLICATION TO MODERN SOCIAL AND CAREER REQUIRE-
3 MENTS, TO ASSIST EACH INDIVIDUAL TO ASSESS REWARDING
4 SOCIAL AND CAREER CHOICES. IT INCLUDES THE UTILIZATION OF
5 CLASSROOM CURRICULA AND COMMUNITY RESOURCES TO PROVIDE
6 STUDENTS WITH A CONTINUAL LEARNING PROCESS THAT INVOLVES
7 AWARENESS, EXPLORATION, AND PURSUIT OF, AND PREPARATION
8 FOR, LIFE ROLES AND CAREERS.

9 21.1-232. Determination of amount to be added to the
10 foundation program for each district.

11 (f) THE AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED IN THE FOUNDATION PRO-
12 GRAM OF A DISTRICT FOR CAREER EDUCATION SHALL BE EQUAL TO
13 ONE (1) ADDITIONAL CLASSROOM UNIT PER FOUR THOUSAND
14 (4,000) AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP. A DISTRICT HAVING LESS
15 THAN FOUR THOUSAND (4,000) AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP SHALL
16 RECEIVE A PROPORTION OF A CLASSROOM UNIT EQUAL TO THE
17 RATIO WHICH THE DISTRICT'S AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP BEARS
18 TO FOUR THOUSAND (4,000). PROGRAMS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO
19 AND APPROVED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, UNDER
20 RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE STATE BOARD OF
21 EDUCATION. FUNDS FOR THIS PROGRAM SHALL NOT DUPLICATE
22 OTHER AREAS OF THE FOUNDATION PROGRAM. THESE FUNDS SHALL
23 BE USED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING AND MAINTAINING
24 A CAREER EDUCATION PROGRAM. THEIR USE SHALL BE LIMITED TO

1 SALARIES FOR PROFESSIONAL AND PARAPROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL,
2 TEACHER IN-SERVICE AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, INSTRUCC-
3 TIONAL MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES FOR THE CAREER EDUCATION
4 CURRICULUM AND TO PROMOTE STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN COMMUNITY
5 BASED LEARNING ACTIVITIES.

6 ~~{f}~~(g) The total amount of the foundation program
7 for each district shall be the sum of the amounts included
8 in subsections (a) through ~~{e}~~-above (f) OF THIS SECTION.

9 Section 2. This act is effective May 27, 1977.
