CHAPTER 91

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION-IDENTIFICATION CARDS

Original House Bill No. 122

AN ACT relating to department of transportation identification cards; eliminating the age restriction for application for a department of transportation identification card; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 31-8-101(a) is amended to read:

31-8-101. Issuance to residents by department; restrictions.

(a) Any Wyoming resident twelve (12) years of age or older-may be issued an identification card by the department of transportation. The application shall state the legal name, correct age and any other identifying data the department may require and shall be signed and verified by the applicant. The identification card shall at the applicant's request indicate that the applicant is an anatomical organ donor. An organ donor card shall be issued to an applicant expressing a desire to be an organ donor. A parent's or guardian's signature is required to authorize the organ donor notation on the identification card of or the issuance of a donor card to persons under eighteen (18) years of age. Requirements for a parent or guardian's signature on the organ donor card are specified in W.S. 35-5-104(b).

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1998.
