That said trade mark has been applied to said merchandise, products of labor, forms of advertising, etc., in Applicant's business since and prior to the 15th day of August, 1922.

That the Radio Corporation of America is the exclusive owner of the trade mark hereinafter described, and that said Corporation has the right to use the same, and that no other person, firm or corporation has the right to use the same either in the identical form or having such resemblance thereto as might be calculated to deceive, and that the fac similes filed herewith are true and correct.

That specimens of said trade mark are hereto attached, shown and more fully described in schedule "A," hereto attached and incorporated herein by reference, with the same force and effect as if herein set forth at length.

SCHEDULE "A"

Trade mark is intended to be used upon wire and radio communication apparatus for transmission and reception of messages, sound and/or pictures including broadcast and television instruments and vacuum tubes; phonographic recording and reproducing apparatus including sound records, photographic recording and reproducing apparatus (including motion picture apparatus and films) with or without sound, musical instruments and entertainment devices, and electrical apparatus.

And on combinations of any of the foregoing together with every attachment, appurtenance, supply, part, device, tool, accessory, machine or part of a machine used in the manufacture, use, sale, transportation, distribution, or storage of any of the foregoing; and upon all present or future, scientific or artistic, patented or other improvements on any of the foregoing; also on prints, publications, pamphlets, circulars, invoices, letters, letter-heads, premiums, tokens, fac simile letters, advertising, advertising copy, mailing lists, billheads, envelopes, order blanks, safety paper, all vouchers of value and the like, containers, dispensers, jackets, bags, bottles, boxes, cartons, and corrugated cartons, receptacles, calendars, advertising novelties, material in sheet form composed or consisting of paper or paper and textiles combined, and for use in wrapping, packing and lining, or for covers or containers for merchandise and articles of the foregoing manufacture and like purposes. While the foregoing list mentions specific articles, Applicant's right, title and interest in and to said trade mark, whether derived from this registration or otherwise acquired, are not to be construed as limited to the articles specified; but all other articles of the same general class or classes are hereby included; and particularly such as fall within the field of the contemplated or natural expansion of the Applicant's business, whether the mark appears individually on specific parts, or on combinations of parts, or circuit components; or whether mark appears individually or jointly on one or more units or compound units of parts, or components; or whether mark appears individually or jointly on kindred fittings, parts, components, or supplies used in any or all of the foregoing apparatus. The right is further claimed for the trade mark as a property by reason of this instrumentality and the further right is reserved to Applicant for other classes of products, merchandise and materials for trade mark purposes.

The essential feature of the trade mark consists of the arbitrarily selected initials and letters "RCA" and claim is made for words, letters or initials which are onomatopoeic. Claim is made to use the letters separately, together, hyphenated or other arrangement and claim is made for the particular and distinct monogram design as associated with the said trade mark, however the essential feature of the trade mark, comprising the initials and letters "RCA," is not limited to the size of the lettering shown on the fac simile, nor to the color indicated therein, nor to the style of the lettering, nor to any particular color; but the right is claimed to use substantially any style or color or arrangement, that may be desired, either with or without ornamentation, illustration, special or distinct design in association with the said trade mark, initials, letters or any component parts thereof.

## RENEWAL FORM

### INSTRUCTIONS

Forms must be submitted in duplicate. One copy will be returned to you with your certificate of renewal registration.

Send three (3) facsimiles or specimens of the trademark or service mark (trade name).

The filing fee is ten dollars (\$10.00). Checks must be made payable to the Secretary of State.

The sworn application must be executed either by the individual applicant, a member of a firm applying (if, for example, a partnership) or an officer of a corporate applicant.

Registration is effective for a term of ten years and is renewable for like term upon application filed within six months prior to expiration of such terms. Renewal forms are available from the office of the Secretary of State and are mailed out to registrants whose trademark is up for renewal.

Assignment forms and copies of the Wyoming Trademarks Act are available from the office of the Secretary of State without charge.
