6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
7	Section 1. W.S. 37-8-401(a)(i)(G), 37-8-402(a)(vii)
8	and 37-8-403(b) and (d) are amended to read:

37-8-401. Fees for use of highways by certain

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- In addition to all fees and taxes now imposed by 1 2 authority of law upon all motor vehicles, semitrailers and trailers, or motor carriers in this state, and in addition 3 to the fees herein provided to be paid to the commission, 4 5 every motor carrier operating on any state highway shall 6 pay to the state board of equalization, for maintenance, repair and reconstruction of the highways, the following 7 8 compensatory fees for the use of the state highways:
- 9 (i) For motor vehicles or legal combinations 10 of vehicles powered with motors using gasoline for fuel shall elect annually to pay compensatory fees monthly at 11 the rate of two and one-half cents (\$.025) per mile 12 traveled, or pay the following fees: 13
- (G) Having an unladen weight of fourteen 14 thousand (14,000) or more pounds and less than sixteen 15 thousand (16,000) pounds, EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF FARM OR 16 RANCH VEHICLES AS PROVIDED IN W.S. 37-8-104(a)(iv), 17 TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (22,500) POUNDS, the 18 compensatory fee shall be eighty-four dollars (\$84.00) per 19 registration year or at the rate of seven dollars (\$7.00) 20 per month, payable in advance for the number of months 21 remaining in the registration year in which the certif-22 23 icate or permit is issued or renewed.

- 1 37-8-402. Fees for certain vehicles not using gaso2 line for fuel.
- a) Motor vehicles or legal combinations of vehicles

  powered with motors not using gasoline for fuel shall

  elect annually to pay compensatory fees monthly at the

  rate of two and one-half cents (\$.025) per mile traveled,

  or pay the following fees:
- (vii) Having an unladen weight of fourteen 8 thousand (14,000) or more pounds and less than sixteen 9 10 thousand (16,000) pounds, EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF FARM OR RANCH VEHICLES AS PROVIDED IN W.S. 37-8-104(a)(iv), 11 TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (22,500) POUNDS, the 12 13 compensatory fee shall be one hundred forty-four dollars (\$144.00) per registration year or at the rate of twelve 14 dollars (\$12.00) per month, payable in advance for the 15 16 number of months remaining in the registration year in 17 which the certificate or permit is issued or renewed.

  37-8-104(a)(iv), TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (22,500)
- 6 POUNDS OR MORE, the compensatory fee is at the rate of one 7 and one-half (1 1/2) mills per ton mile on the unladen
- 8 weight, as defined in W.S. 37-131-(u) 37-8-101(a)(xxi).
- 9 (d) For freight or express service, for motor vehicles or legal combinations of vehicles not using gasoline 10 fuel and having an unladen weight of sixteen thousand 11 (16,000) pounds or more, EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF FARM OR 12 13 VEHICLES AS PROVIDED IN W.S. 37-8-104(a)(iv), 14 TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (22,500) POUNDS OR MORE, the compensatory fee is at the rate of one and one-half (1 15 16 1/2) mills per ton mile on the unladen weight of the vehicle, as defined in W.S. 37-131-(u) 37-8-101 (a) (xxi), and 17 to such compensatory fees upon vehicles burning fuels 18 other than gasoline, there is further added an additional 19 tax upon the special fuels burned by the vehicles measured 20 at the rate of one and one tenth (1.1) mills per ton mile 21 on the unladen weight of the vehicle burning special 22 fuels, as defined in W.S. 37-131-(u) 37-8-101(a)(xxi), the 23 24 additional tax to replace and to be in lieu of the hereto-

- fore existing fees based on the average mileage per gallon
- of special fuels consumed by the vehicles burning special
- 3 fuels and limited by the weight of the vehicles.
- 4 Section 2. This act is effective May 27, 1983.

A spokesman from the Department of Revenue and Taxation estimated the following impact to the Department in 1983:

The following impact to the Highway Fund was based on Department of Revenue and Taxation <u>estimates</u> from 1979 figures.

Using the estimated fee for yearly flat rate with gas and without gas operated vehicles, the estimated increase to the Highway Fund in 1983 is \$231,562.49.

Using the \$.025 option, the estimated loss to the Highway Fund in 1983 is \$16,141.66.
