6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 13-43.17 through 13-43.20 are  
8 created to read:

9 13-43.17. Definition. "Automatic teller station"  
10 means any off-premises, unmanned, automated unit at which  
11 an existing customer may initiate banking transactions  
12 including, but not limited to, cash deposits to or with-  
13 drawals from an account, cash advances on a pre-authorized  
14 line of credit, transfers between checking and savings  
15 accounts, payment transfers from accounts of the customer  
16 to accounts of other banking customers, dispensing of

1 cash, payment of loan proceeds on a prearranged line of  
2 credit or receipt of loan payments. An automatic teller  
3 station shall not be considered a branch bank.

4 13-43.18. Authorization to operate automatic teller  
5 stations. Subject to the conditions and limitations con-  
6 tained in this act, any state or national bank may estab-  
7 lish and operate an automatic teller station or stations  
8 anywhere within the same county in which the bank has its  
9 principal place of business as set forth in its articles  
10 of incorporation.

11 13-43.19. Notice of intention required. A notifica-  
12 tion of intention to establish or relocate and operate an  
13 automatic teller station shall be filed with the state  
14 examiner in the form and manner established by his office.

15 13-43.20. Authorization to close automatic teller  
16 stations. Any state or national bank may close its exist-  
17 ing automatic teller station or stations at any time upon  
18 ten (10) days' prior written notice to the state examiner.

1       Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon  
2       completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
3       as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Con-  
4       stitution.




