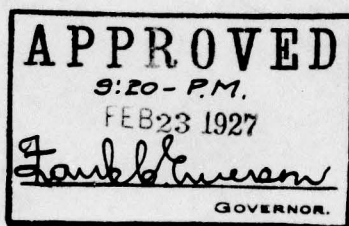
A Resolution authorizing the Nineteenth State Legislature of Wyoming to accept certain bronze tablets donated by the Women's Relief Corps of the States of Wyoming and Colorado.

WHEREAS, the Women's Relief Corps for the States of Wyoming and Colorado, an Auxiliary to the Grand Army of the Republic, through their legislative committee, Mrs. Dora C. Newell, Chairman, have tendered two bronze tablets to the State of Wyoming: one inscribed with General John A. Logan's Order No. 11, dated May 15, 1868, designating May 30th as Memorial Day, a day sacred to the Memory of the Comrades of the Civil War, and a companion tablet called the Lincoln tablet, with suitable inscription thereon;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the Nineteenth State Legislature of the State of Wyoming, the Senate concurring, that said bronze tablets, which the Women's Relief Corps of Wyoming and Colorado desire to present to the State of Wyoming, shall be accepted and placed in a suitable location to be designated by the Capitol Building Commission.
