JOINT MEMORIAL NO. 3 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Memorializing Congress for the restriction of immigration.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

That the Congress of the United States be memorialized as follows:

Your memorialist, the Legislature of the State of Wyoming, having in view the welfare and wishes of the people of this State, declare unqualifiedly in favor of the adequate restriction by Congress of the United States of immigration thereto from foreign countries. The interests of the entire people demand a speedy relief and your memorialist therefore prays and earnestly urges the Honorable Congress of the United States to immediately enact such laws as will properly restrict the indiscriminate immigration that now threatens to overwhelm this nation: and as in duty bound your memorialist will ever pray, etc.

RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, That an authenticated copy of this memorial and resolution be forwarded by the Secretary of State to each Senator, and to the Representative in Congress from this State, and they are hereby respectfully requested to present the same to the Honorable, the Senate and the Honorable, the House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, and to urge necessary legislation in the premises.
