6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 21-13-501 and 21-13-502 are amended
8 to read:

9 21-13-501. Board of trustees of any school district
10 authorized to hold election; building or repayment fund

1 generally.

2 (a) The board of trustees of any school district
3 may, whenever a majority thereof so decide, submit to the
4 electors of the district the question whether the board
5 shall be authorized to start a building fund of a certain
6 amount, to be raised within a certain number of years, for
7 the purpose of acquiring land, erection, enlargement, and
8 equipping school buildings, teacherages, garages, or other
9 such buildings as may be needed for school purposes
10 therein, OR SUBMIT THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE BOARD IS
11 AUTHORIZED TO DIRECT THE COUNTY TREASURER TO ANNUALLY LEVY
12 AGAINST THE PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT TO PAY OFF EXISTING
13 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR SCHOOL FACILITY AUTHORITY REFUNDING
14 BONDS OF A CERTAIN AMOUNT, not to exceed four percent (4%)

10 PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT TO PAY OFF EXISTING REFUNDING
11 BONDS, YES" AND "LEVY AGAINST THE PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT
12 TO PAY OFF EXISTING REFUNDING BONDS, NO". If the majority


