

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting the Congress of the United
2 States to grant the President of the United States the
3 authority to line-item veto legislation.

4

5 WHEREAS, our system of government relies on the three (3)
6 branches of government balancing one another in their
7 actions and powers; and

8

9 WHEREAS, forty-four (44) states allow their governors the
10 power to line-item veto legislation; and

11

12 WHEREAS, the line-item veto authority provides the executive
13 branch with the flexibility it may need to deal with
14 legislation presented to it by the legislative branch; and

15

16 WHEREAS, the line-item veto authority permits the executive
17 branch to eliminate portions of legislative proposals
18 containing appropriations; and

2 WHEREAS, the line-item veto authority can be an important
3 tool in the reduction of excessive government spending; and

4

5 WHEREAS, Wyoming has been particularly well-served by its
6 line-item veto authority which is limited to bills
7 containing appropriations and allows the governor the reduce
8 appropriations.

9

10 Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By The Members of the
11 Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

12

13 **Section 1.** That the Congress of the United States
14 expeditiously pass, and propose to the legislatures of the
15 several states for ratification, an amendment to the
16 Constitution of the United States granting line-item veto
17 authority to the President of the United States; and

18

1 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State transmit copies
2 of this resolution to the President of the United States
3 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the
4 United States, each member of the Wyoming Congressional
5 Delegation, and the Secretary of State and the presiding
6 officer of each House of the Legislatures of the other
7 States in the Union.
