This office is a division of the Department of Employment, and is located in Rock Springs. It is the responsibility of this office to administer the State Statutes pertaining to the health and safety of the miners, and to recommend legislative changes in such regulations when needed.

Pursuant to these Statutes, each mining operation in the State is inspected for compliance several times each year, and all fatal or serious accidents are investigated. Complaints by employees of unsafe working conditions are also investigated.

State Statutes also created the Mining Council, composed of 10 members and the State Inspector of Mines. The membership is composed of 5 management and 5 hourly representatives from various types of mining operations. The members of the Council act in conjunction with the State Inspector of Mines to improve the health and safety in the mines of this state.

The State Mining Council is also responsible for the certification of underground and surface mine foreman and underground mine examiners as required by State Statutes. The members of the Mining Council are:

INSPECTION ACTIVITIES

The State Mine Inspector's Office conducted 721 health and safety inspections at active mines, inactive mines, AML Projects and plant sites during 2006. Contractor activity at these sites was also inspected.

Many spot checks and return inspections were also made to confirm that action was taken on corrections requested, and to monitor problem areas and conditions.

Several Accident investigations were carried out and investigations were made into incidents which could have caused injury during 2006. Procedures were recommended to prevent their reoccurrence. These were made in cooperation with companies involved, labor and the Mine Safety and Health Administration.

FATALITIES

Although there were some very serious accidents, there were **NO** mine related fatalities in 2006.

ACCIDENTS

Total reported mine operator and mine site contractor employment increased by 1838 people in 2006.

There were 126 lost time accidents reported in 2006. This accident count is a decrease from the 134 reported in 2005. Of those involved, 95 were mining company employees and 31 were mining contractor employees.

Lost work days were also reduced drastically from the 6058 days reported in 2005 to 4181 in 2006.

This accomplishment is a direct result of efforts by management and labor to make the mines in Wyoming safer places to work.

TRAINING

Mine Safety and Health training is available through the M.S.H.A. State Grant Program which is funded by a grant awarded to the State Mine Inspector by the Department of Labor. There are full time and contract trainers located at the Northern Wyoming Community College District, Gillette College and at the Western Wyoming Community College, Green River Campus. These instructors conduct training on campus and also travel throughout the state upon request. There were 7,050 students taught by these trainers in 2006.

Accident Investigation and Prevention	

On November 7 and 8, 2006, the State Grant Program and the State Mine Inspector's Office jointly sponsored the 11th Annual Wyoming Mine Safety Conference.

Programs were presented by the State's Grant Program, personnel from this office. Other presenters were: American Heart Association, Bear Tooth K-9, Casper Police Department, members of industry and MSHA. Some of the subjects were the new American Heart Association CPR standards, Electrical safety, Drug in the Workplace by the Casper Police Department and Bear Tooth K-9, and a History of Mining presentation and a Lost Time Accident Comparison by Deputy Inspectors Mike McCann and Tom McDonald.

I encourage all of the mines and mine contractors to use the Grant Program whenever possible.

EXAMINER / MINE FOREMAN CERTIFICATION

The Wyoming Mining Council is responsible for the certification of Mine Examiners and Mine Foreman in the state. In 2006, 19 Examiner certificates and 150 Foreman certificates were issued. Following is a list of the Mine Examiners and Mine Foremen certified in 2006.

COAL

During 2006, the reported coal production was 444,880,617 tons. This surpasses the record that was set in 2005 by 40,391,759 tons.

Thunder Basin Coal Company's, Black Thunder Mine, led all producers in 2006 with 92,517,728 tons.

Reported coal mine employment was 6,030. This is an increase of 700 employees from 2005.

Thunder Basin Coal Company's Coal Creek Mine was reopened during the year. The mine produced 3.1 million tons of coal. If markets are available, the mine could produce 15 million ton per year.

Mine development has begun at Arch Mineral's, Elk Mountain Mine at Hanna. The coal that is produced will be shipped out of the company's Seminoe II load out facility.

There were 87 coal contractors that responded to our request for information. They had 2,976 employees compared to 2,751 in 2005.

BENTONITE

Bentonite mine production was up considerably in 2006. It was 6,102,218 tons, up 897,929 tons from 2005.

Bentonite plant production was also up in 2006. It was 4,911,306 tons, up 294,898 tons from last year.

Overall the industry reported steady growth in all of their markets.

The combined plant and mine employment was 798, down slightly from the 815 reported last year.

There were 17 contractors who responded to our request for information. They had 312 employees which is a considerable increase over the 242 figure reported in 2005.

URANIUM

Surface mining activity continues to be confined to the reclamation of existing mine sites.

One processing mill remains on standby. The rest have been decommissioned and the mill sites have been reclaimed.

All of the uranium production in 2006 came from the In-Situ mining operations.

Production in 2006 was 2,043,876 lbs. U-308, all from Power Resources, Inc's Smith Ranch Mine. This is an increase of 747,298 lbs. from last year.

There was no production from conventional mining.

Total uranium mine employment was 138, down from 145 in 2005.

Western Nuclear Inc., Pathfinder, Lucky Mc Mine and Petrotomics have completed their tails impoundment reclamation and are waiting for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to release the sites.

The COGEMA Mining Inc. Irrigary and Christensen mines have been reclaimed.

A Canadian Company, Uranium One is in the process of acquiring U.S. Energy's Sheep Mountain Properties.

Kennecott Uranium Company is planning a drilling program on the Big Eagle and Round Park properties on Green Mountain.

Uranerz Energy Corporation has started drilling on their Johnson County properties.

There were 11 contractors that responded to our request for information. They had 296 employees. This is up considerably from the 59 employees that were reported in 2005.
