IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDED APPLICATION OF NATURAL GAS PROCESSING CO., THROUGH ITS DIVISIONS WYOMING GAS COMPANY AND NG TRANSMISSION FOR AUTHORITY TO TRANSFER THE UTILITY ASSETS OF NG TRANSMISSION TO WYOMING GAS COMPANY, AND FOR NG TRANSMISSION TO DISCONTINUE UTILITY SERVICE CURRENTLY OFFERED TO THE PUBLIC-DOCKET NOS. 30009-60-GR-16 and 50051-2-PR-16 (RECORD NO. 14566)

LETTER ORDER

(Issued October 18, 2017)

Dear Counsel:

On October 9, 2017, Natural Gas Processing Co. (NGP), through its divisions Wyoming Gas Company (WCG or the Company) and NG Transmission (NGT) submitted its supplemental response to Commission Investigative Request (CIR) 8.7. On October 9, 2017, WCG filed a *Petition for Confidential Treatment of Certain Data Response and Exhibits (Petition)* requesting confidential treatment of its supplemental response to CIR 8.7 because the identified information contains confidential customer, commercial, financial and revenue data that, if disclosed, would likely cause harm to the Company and its customers.

Chapter 2, Section 30 of the Commission's Rules provides, in part:

(a) Upon petition, and for good cause shown, the Commission shall deem confidential any information filed with the Commission or in the custody of the Commission or staff which is shown to be of the nature described in Wyoming Statute §16-4-203(a), (b), (d) or (g). All information for which confidential treatment is requested shall be treated as confidential until the Commission rules whether, and to what extent, the information shall be given confidential treatment.

The Company's *Petition* came before the Commission pursuant to due notice at its Open Meeting on October 17, 2017. Commission Counsel recommended granting the *Petition*.

The Commission finds that the Company's *Petition* is generally consistent with the provisions of Chapter 2, Section 30 of the Commission's Rules and the information described therein is of the character subject to protection under this Rule. The Commission concludes that the Company has shown good cause for its request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Pursuant to Open Meeting action taken on October 17, 2017, Natural Gas Processing Co., through its divisions Wyoming Gas Company and NG Transmission's *Petition for Confidential Treatment of Certain Data and Exhibits* filed on October 9, 2017, is granted.

2. This *Letter Order* is effective immediately.
