A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to Article 1,
 2 Section 28 and Article 15, Section 11 of the Constitution
 3 of the State of Wyoming to clarify the power of the legis-
 4 lature to classify property, to authorize a method of val-
 5 uation for agricultural lands and to provide that the per-
 6 cent of fair market value assessed for property tax pur-
 7 poses may vary within certain limitations among classes of
 8 property as designated by the legislature.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
 10 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
 11 separately, concurring therein:

12 Section 1. The following amendment to Article 1,

NO SIGNIFICANT FISCAL IMPACT

1 Section 28 and Article 15, Section 11 of the Wyoming Con-
2 stitution is proposed for submission to the electors of
3 the State of Wyoming at the next general election for
4 approval or rejection, to become valid as a part of the
5 Constitution if ratified by a majority of the electors
6 voting at the election. The amendment is as follows:

7 Article 1, Section 28. Taxation; consent of people;
8 uniformity and equality. No tax shall be imposed without
9 the consent of the people or their authorized representa-
10 tives. ~~All-taxation-shall-be-equal-and-uniform-~~

11 Article 15, Section 11. Uniformity of assessment
12 required.

13 (a) All property, except as in this constitution
14 otherwise provided, AND EXCLUDING AGRICULTURAL AND GRAZING
15 LANDS WHICH SHALL BE VALUED AS PROVIDED BY THE LEGISLATURE
16 AT A VALUE BASED ON THE CURRENT USE AND PRODUCTIVITY,
17 shall be uniformly assessed-~~for-taxation,-and-the-legisla-~~
18 ~~ture-shall-prescribe-such-regulations-as--shall--secure--a~~
19 ~~just-valuation-for-taxation-of-all-property,-real-and-per-~~
20 ~~sonal-~~ VALUED AT ITS FAIR MARKET VALUE AS DEFINED BY THE
21 LEGISLATURE, IN AT LEAST THREE (3) CLASSES AS FOLLOWS:

22 (i) GROSS PRODUCTION OF MINERALS AND MINE

1 PRODUCTS IN LIEU OF TAXES ON THE LAND WHERE PRODUCED;

2 (ii) MANUFACTURING AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY;

3 AND

4 (iii) ALL OTHER PROPERTY, REAL AND PERSONAL.

5 (b) THE LEGISLATURE SHALL PRESCRIBE BY LAW THE PER-
6 CENTAGE OF THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF PROPERTY, OR OTHER
7 VALUE IN THE CASE OF AGRICULTURAL AND GRAZING LANDS, WHICH
8 SHALL BE TAXED WITHIN EACH DESIGNATED CLASS. THE PERCENT-
9 AGE ESTABLISHED FOR MANUFACTURING AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY
10 SHALL SHALL NEVER EXCEED THE PERCENTAGE ESTABLISHED FOR
11 ALL OTHER PROPERTY BY MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE
12 PERCENT (125%).

13 (c) ALL TAXATION SHALL BE EQUAL AND UNIFORM WITHIN
14 EACH CLASS OF PROPERTY. THE LEGISLATURE SHALL PRESCRIBE
15 SUCH REGULATIONS AS SHALL SECURE A JUST VALUATION FOR TAX-
16 ATION OF ALL PROPERTY, REAL AND PERSONAL.

17 Section 2. The following statement shall be endorsed
18 on the foregoing amendment by the Secretary of State of
