16 years and who has continuously resided in Wyoming for at
17 least the thirty (30) years immediately preceding

1 application for the license, or to any disabled veteran who
2 is one hundred percent (100%) disabled as determined by the
3 United States department of veteran affairs. The license is
4 valid so long as the licensee remains a Wyoming resident.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2000.


