This bill makes it possible for individuals over the age of 21 who qualify under Title XIX of the Social Security Act to receive dental protheses. In order to be eligible an individual would have to be receiving public assistance (either supplemental security income or aid to families with dependent children). The bill carries an appropriation of \$750,000 for fiscal year 1978. Additional general fund appropriations will be needed in the future to continue this program.
