Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wyoming:

Section 1. Whenever in any case, which is now pending or which shall be instituted in the supreme court of the Territory of Wyoming, a party is or shall be required to furnish a printed paper, proceeding or file, the same shall be deemed to be duly printed, if written or typed upon a machine commonly known as and called a type-writer.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
