5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 23-1-701(b) and (c) is amended to
7 read:

8 23-1-701. Selling agents; appointment; bond; compen-
9 sation; monthly remittance and report; account for sur-
10 plus, unused and damaged licenses; authority to administer
11 oaths; game tags; beaver tags.

(b) ~~Each selling agent shall retain twenty-five cents--(\$.25)--for each license he sells. For failure to comply with this section, selling agents shall not be entitled to twenty-five cents--(\$.25)--per license sold and shall be liable on their bond.~~ No employee of the commission shall receive any commission on licenses or tags sold.

8 (c) On or before the 10th of each month every
9 selling agent shall file a report for the preceding month
10 with the commission on forms approved by the commission.
11 Selling agents shall also remit all money collected during
12 the previous month ~~less-commission~~, and shall account for
13 and deliver all surplus, unused and damaged licenses,
14 tags, and stubs of licenses received by the selling agent
15 to the commission. BASED ON THIS REPORT, THE COMMISSION
16 SHALL RETURN TO THE SELLING AGENT, FIVE PERCENT (5%) OF
17 THE AMOUNT COLLECTED DURING THAT PREVIOUS MONTH.

18 Section 2. This act is effective May 25, 1979.
