6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 33-26-410 by creating a new subsec-
8 tion (d) is amended to read:

9 33-26-410. Effect of violation; alteration of medi-
10 cal records.

1 (d) WHOEVER KNOWINGLY AND INTENTIONALLY ALTERS OR
2 CHANGES THE CONTENTS OF MEDICAL RECORDS OR REPORTS SO AS
3 TO PRESENT A FALSE OR MISLEADING DESCRIPTION OF MEDICAL
4 TREATMENT ACTUALLY PROVIDED, SHALL BE DEEMED GUILTY OF A
5 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY THOU-
6 SAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00) OR IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN
7 TEN (10) YEARS, OR BOTH. EACH VIOLATION CONSTITUTES A
8 SEPARATE OFFENSE FOR WHICH THE PENALTY IN THIS SUBSECTION
9 MAY BE ASSESSED.

10 Section 2. This act is effective June 9, 1988.
