AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 9-1203, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, relating to the carrying of dangerous or deadly weapons.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-1203, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 9-1203. Every person, \* \* \* who shall wear or carry any dirk, pistol, bowie knife, dagger, sword in cane, or any other dangerous or deadly weapon concealed, or who shall carry or wear any such weapon openly, with the intent, or avowed purpose, of injuring his fellow-man, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), AND IN ADDITION TO SUCH FINE, SAID WEAPON OR WEAPONS SHALL BE CONFISCATED BY THE COURT. THE COURT WILL CAUSE SUCH CONFISCATED WEAPON OR WEAPONS TO BE SOLD AT PUBLIC AUCTION TO THE HIGHEST BIDDER, AND THE PROCEEDS THEREFROM SHALL BE COVERED INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH SUCH CONFISCATION IS MADE.
