6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 27-14-616(b) (intro) is amended to  
8 read:

9 27-14-616. MEDICAL COMMISSION; HEARING PANELS; CRE-  
10 ATION; MEMBERSHIP; DUTIES; RULEMAKING.

11 (b) One (1) member shall be elected by commission

1 members as chairman and one (1) as vice-chairman. The  
2 division shall designate an employee to serve as executive  
3 secretary of the commission or contract with an individual  
4 to provide executive secretary services to the commission.

5 The governor may appoint no more than eleven (11) addi-  
6 tional health care providers as associate members of the  
7 commission whose function is limited to serving as members  
8 of individual medical hearing panels. Except for initial  
9 members, the terms of commission members and associate  
10 members shall be three (3) years. Three (3) members of  
11 the initial commission and three (3) initial associate  
12 members shall be appointed to a one (1) year term and four  
13 (4) initial commission members and four (4) initial asso-  
14 ciate members shall be appointed to a two (2) year term.  
15 The duties of the commission shall be:

16 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon  
17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-  
19 tution.
