

HB0232 Surveyors and engineers-licensing.

AN ACT relating to professional engineers and land surveyors; renaming the state board of registration for professional engineers and professional land surveyors as the Wyoming board of examiners for engineering and surveying; substituting the term license requirement for the term registration requirement; conforming provisions accordingly; providing definitions; modifying intern and professional license qualifications; expanding practice by corporations to partnerships and limited liability companies; specifying application to existing registered practitioners; and providing for an effective date.


