



6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 24-2-110(c) introductory paragraph
8 and (ii) is amended to read:

9 24-2-110. Cooperation with counties in construction
10 of county roads; allocation of costs; state-county road
11 construction account established.

1 (c) Ten percent (10%) of gasoline license tax reve-
2 nues distributed by the state treasurer ~~money~~ under W.S.
3 39-6-210(d)(i) shall be placed in a separate account and
4 be expended by the commission solely for payment of the
5 state's share of the state-county road construction pro-
6 gram and as otherwise provided in this subsection. This
7 money shall be allocated as follows:

(ii) The remainder to the counties and the share allocated to each county shall be based fifty percent (50%) upon the percentage ratio which the rural population of each county bears to the rural population of the state according to the last federal census and fifty percent (50%) based upon the percentage ratio which the area of each county bears to the area of the state. Any interest earned on the investment of funds in the account created by this subsection shall be credited to each ~~county's~~ COUNTY AND MAY BE USED FOR THE SEVEN PERCENT (7%) matching fund ~~requirements~~ REQUIREMENT under subsection (b) of this section AND FOR PROJECT COSTS AS AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION.
