## A BILL for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the  
 2 Constitution of the State of Wyoming by amending  
 3 Section 1, Article 20 thereof relating to the  
 4 required approval of constitutional amendments  
 5 to be that of a majority approval of those  
 6 electors actually voting on the specific amendment.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF  
 8 WYOMING, two-thirds of all members of each of the two  
 9 houses, voting separately, concurring therein:

10 Section 1. That the following amendment to Section  
 11 1, Article 20 of the Constitution of the State of Wyoming  
 12 is proposed for verbatim submission to the electors of  
 13 the state of Wyoming at the next general election to be  
 14 held in the state, for approval or rejection, to become  
 15 valid as a part of said Constitution if ratified by a  
 16 majority of such electors. The amendment is as follows:

17 (a) Any amendment or amendments to this Constitution  
 18 may be proposed in either branch of the legislature, and,  
 19 if the same shall be agreed to by two-thirds of all the  
 20 members of each of the two houses, voting separately,

1 such proposed amendment or amendments shall, with the  
2 yeas and nays thereon, be entered on their journals, and  
3 it shall be the duty of the legislature to submit such  
4 amendment or amendments to the electors of the state at  
5 the next general election, and cause the same to be  
6 published without delay for at least twelve (12)  
7 consecutive weeks, prior to said election, in at least  
8 one newspaper of general circulation, published in each  
9 county, and if a majority of the electors VOTING UPON  
10 THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT OR AMENDMENTS shall ratify the  
11 same, such amendment or amendments shall become a part  
12 of this Constitution.

13 Section 2. The following statement shall be endorsed  
14 on the foregoing proposed amendment by the secretary of  
15 state of the state of Wyoming:

16 (a) This proposed amendment to the Constitution of  
17 the State of Wyoming insures passage of Constitutional  
18 amendments to the Wyoming Constitution when an amendment  
19 receives majority approval of those electors who actually  
20 vote on the amendment.
