

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to repeal W.S. 27-5-102 through 27-5-107 relating
2 to a working day in mines and reduction and smelting works
3 and penalties for violations of working day limitations;
4 and providing for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 27-5-102 through 27-5-107 are
7 repealed.

8 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
9 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
10 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Con-
11 stitution.


