BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 5180 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes 1910, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

"Section 5180. In precincts having a population of more than fifteen hundred, justices of the peace shall receive the following annual salaries: In precincts having a population of more than five thousand, nine hundred dollars; in precincts having a population of more than three thousand and less than five thousand, six hundred dollars; and in precincts having a population of more than fifteen hundred and less than three thousand, five hundred dollars. Justices of the peace in precincts having a population of more than fifteen hundred shall the same fees as are provided in the succeeding section, and shall pay the same into the county treasury."

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
