Mission and philosophy

The Wyoming Governor's Residence is a state owned, semi-public building that serves as the home for the Governor and his family and also serves the state by providing a place to display Wyoming's history, art, antiques, and artifacts, thereby providing the people of Wyoming with a visible symbol of state history and culture

The private role of the Governor's Residence is to provide the Governor and his family a safe, comfortable, family home during his tenure as the Governor. The Governor's Residence is the only place where privacy is available to the Governor and his family. The Governor's Residence is the site for most of the official functions that the Governor and First Lady conduct on behalf of the State of Wyoming. Official functions include entertaining legislators and their spouses, elected officials, visiting government and business officials, and state and foreign dignitaries.

The public role of the Governor's Residence is to provide opportunities to visit and utilize the residence. Public functions include tours, educational tours for students, meetings, luncheons, teas, and receptions. The Governor's Residence tour schedule is Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9:00am to 3:00pm. However, the residence is accessible for tours five days a week, Monday through Friday. Special events may be scheduled through the residence manager or events coordinator.

Results of outcomes

Approximately 3500 people visited the Governor's Residence during the period July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004.
